

Winter Mitten

Supplies included in kit:

- Polyester fill
- Child-size mitten
- Cardboard – 2 ½ x 3 ¼ inches
- Homespun fabric – ¾ x 14 inches
- Wooden snowflake – 2 inches diameter
- Twine hanger
- Aluminum wire – 12 inches
- Wrapped floral wire – 2 x 6 inches
- Pine branches
- Pip berry twigs
- Miniature pinecones

Additional supplies you will need:

- Scissors

Directions:

1. Put your fingers/hand into the mitten to help stretch it out.
2. Stuff the fingers and thumb with polyester fill.
3. Slide the cardboard into the top of the mitten, with the angled side pointing down. If it's too wide for the mitten, trim the edges.
4. Poke the ends of the wire through the top of the mitten to make a hanger. Twist the ends back around the wire to secure them.
5. Arrange the pine branches and pip berries in the top.
6. Twist a piece of floral wire around a pinecone and make a loop with the extra length. Tuck it in front of the branches, and repeat with the second pinecone.
7. Tie the twine hanger around the snowflake and trim off any unwanted length.
8. Slide the snowflake hanger onto the homespun strip, and tie the homespun around the top of the mitten. Double knot it.
9. Hang up and enjoy!
