

Jute Easter Eggs

Supplies included in kit:

- Plastic Easter eggs
- Rope or twine (5mm jute rope will use about 6 ½ ft per egg, a thick twine will use 9 ft, thin twine will use more)
- Miscellaneous ribbon (7 in. will wrap around the middle of the egg)
- Small silk flower
- Hot glue gun
- Hot glue sticks
- Finger guard

Additional supplies you will need:

- Scissors



Directions:

1. Plug in the glue gun to start heating.
2. **Tip:** It helps to glue the egg shut before you start wrapping!
3. To begin, coil the end of the rope or twine in a spiral. Hot glue the spiral to one end of the egg.
4. Continue to wrap the rope around the egg, hot gluing as you go.
5. When you get to the end of the egg, trim the rope and glue the end down.
6. Glue a strip of ribbon around the middle of the egg.
7. If you want, you can decorate it more with a flower and a little bow.
8. Wrap the other eggs to make a trio. Set them out and enjoy!
